### What's on in West Howe for YOU?

- Alex from West Howe Community Enterprise are offering a fantastic opportunity for you to undertake a free training course to gain a Level 2 qualification in Understanding Health Improvement, funded by Public Health Dorset, in order to help improve the health of the West Howe community. The training will take place over two mornings (followed by a free lunch) and cover the topics of physical activity, healthy diet, smoking and alcohol as well as the principles of promoting health improvement, health inequalities and effective communication.
