

Year 4: I want my Mummy!

During this topic the children will learn about the ancient Egyptians.

As Scientists, the children will be identifying how sounds are made. They will learn about vibrations from sounds and find patterns between volume and strengths of sound.

As Historians, the children will be learning about Howard Carter and his discovery of the tomb of King Tutankhamen. During this topic, they will focus on the significance of the pyramids and study ancient Egyptian beliefs. They will also consider the importance of the River Nile to both ancient Egyptian lifestyle and modern day Egypt.



In Art the children will be improving their design techniques through the use of clay. The motivation for their creations will be ancient Egyptian sculpture.

In RE, the children will be focusing on Judaism and learning about Passover. During this topic, they will be visiting a local synagogue to learn more about Jewish practices and beliefs.

Home Learning:

As independent learners, we would like the children to create a model of the River Nile. We would encourage the children to make an annotated plan of their ideas before creating their model. Please bring both of these into school by Monday 6th February 2017.
