

# TIMINGS



The school gates open at 8.40 each morning and you can enter the school premises by two gates on Hadow Road or there is an entrance on Bennion Road.

To reflect the 15 hours funding, **Pre-School pupils** are offered a choice of 4 timings and the Bennion Road entrance is used for dropping off and collection for those sessions that fall outside of the schools main opening hours.

We are only able to offer a limited number of each sessions with a maximum number of pupils in at one time.

Monday and Tuesday 8.50-3.10 and Wednesday 8.50-11.30

Wednesday 12.30-3.10, Thursday and Friday 8.50-3.10

5 mornings- 8.30-11.30 (you can bring your child in at 8.40 or the Bennion Road gate will be opened at 8.30 and then again for collection at 11.30)

5 afternoons- 12.30-3.30 (you can collect your child from 3.10 onwards.) Please bring your child to the Bennion Road gate at 12.30.

Places are offered to children the term after they turn three and are offered in priority order as outlined in our admissions policy. Application forms are available at the school office.

**A place in our Pre-School does not guarantee a place in the Reception class and applications have to be made for Reception places through the Local Authority admissions procedure.**

## Breakfast and After School Club

We offer Breakfast Club and After School provision, both run by school staff

There is a £5 registration fee per child per year

### Breakfast Club:

7.45am—8.40am £2 per day

### After School Club:

Half Session 3.15-4.30 £3.50

Full Session 3.15-5.45 £7.50

(includes a snack)

Application forms for both can be completed at the office or on Wisepay (login details are available from the office).

Places for both After School Club and Breakfast club must be booked in advance and by 10am on the day for After school Club. Children attending both Breakfast and After school club must be registered before attending.

# Kingsleigh Pre-School



## Uniform

Pre School aged pupils will need:

- A red polo shirt
- Grey jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts (these are more practical than school trousers or dresses)
- Navy jumper or cardigan (Kingsleigh badge ones available from the office)
- Sensible Velcro shoes (trainers are fine)
- Book bag (available from school office)
- A warm coat for winter months
- A sun hat for summer months
- We also recommend your child comes to school with a spare set of named clothes in case of accidents

Your child is likely to get messy at Pre-School so please make sure any uniform or coats are appropriate!

**Please ensure all uniform is named!!**



3 Year old funding for 15 hours of childcare starts the term after your child turns 3. Your child is eligible to start at Kingsleigh Pre-School as soon as they turn 3 if you wish and sessions can be paid for at £15 per session (see Top Up sessions).

Our Pre School is run by a qualified Teacher, Miss Kurtul and she is supported by two Nursery Nurses Mrs Spencer-Frost and Mrs Denison and a classroom assistant Miss Noles. The Pre-School is split over two rooms. Throughout the day both rooms and the outside area will be used by all pupils attending the Pre School.

Play is at the heart of all our learning and we aim to give them a broad and balance curriculum. Within the EYFS framework there are 7 areas of learning:

Personal Social and Emotional development, Physical Development, Communication and Language, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding of the World, Expressive Arts and Design. We will share your child's achievements and progress through their Learning Journeys which you will be able to access online and though parents evenings offered twice a year.

## Lunches

Children attending a full day can order hot school meals through Wisepay and cost £2.40 per day. Alternatively children can bring in a healthy lunch box.

## Top Up Sessions

Due to demand we now offer paid for top up sessions.

These can be booked online via wise pay for the whole term ahead.

As we have to adhere to strict guidelines for staff to pupil ratio top up sessions are restricted and are offered subject to availability.

You can buy either:

- A morning session 8:50—12:30 for £15
- An afternoon session 11:30—3:10 for £15

This will enable a child who attends half days to do a full day and stay for lunch.

Or both a morning and afternoon session for £30 so you can book in a whole extra day..
